What is NCS?

The Nation Citizen Service (NCS) is a government funded social integration programme that aims to bring communities together and build the skills and confidence of young people. The Challenge is responsible for delivering NCS in the Greater Manchester area and will engage with several thousand young people this summer.

How?

We are currently looking for charities, community groups and organisations to;

- Have a group interact with their service users through a skill such as art, drama or photography.
- Engage with a group around a social action project which they then fundraise for and volunteer on.

Also we are looking for businesses and individuals that would be willing to;

- Host a group at their workplace for around 1 hour; showing them around, explaining what you do.
- Be a 'Dragon' as our young people pitch their ideas for social action to a panel.

When?

The NCS programme runs during the school summer holidays. We have many dates to fill and can be flexible about timings up to a point. Most activities take place between 9-5 including weekends.
