The ICSPs will work with GMP and other community oversight groups such as the Independent Advisory Groups (IAGs) to build and maintain trust and confidence within our local communities.

We want you to give your honest opinions and bring us to account. Through showing you police interactions captured on Body Worn Video (BWV) and data, we seek your personal views about how it we are doing so that we can be transparent in all we do.
